- are valued and able to meet their own needs by utilizing their talents, potential and passions.



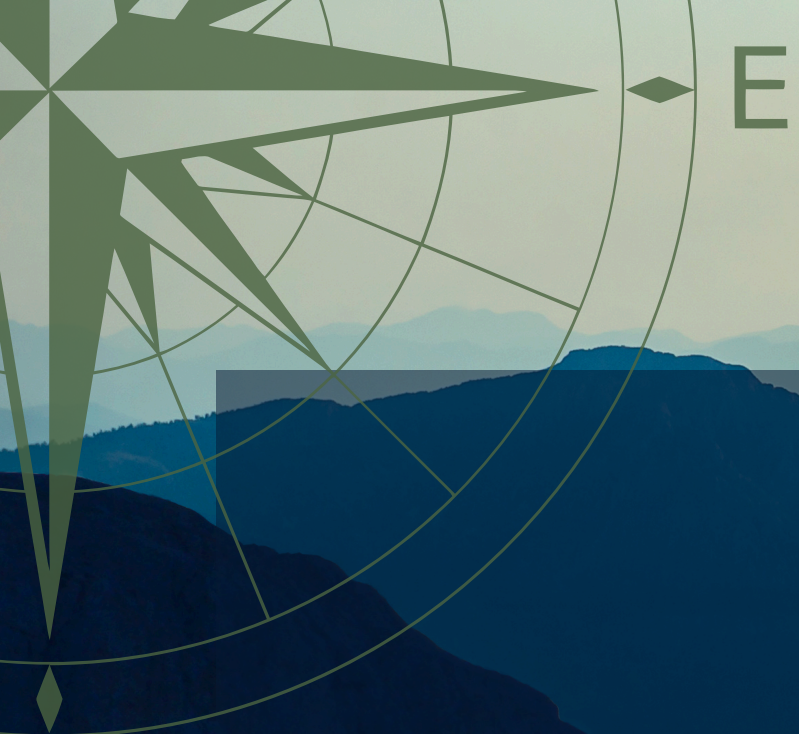
Stabilize ~ Equip ~ Engage

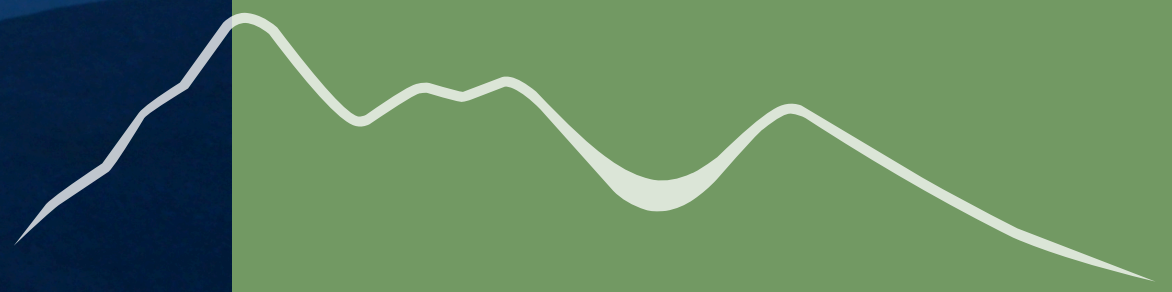

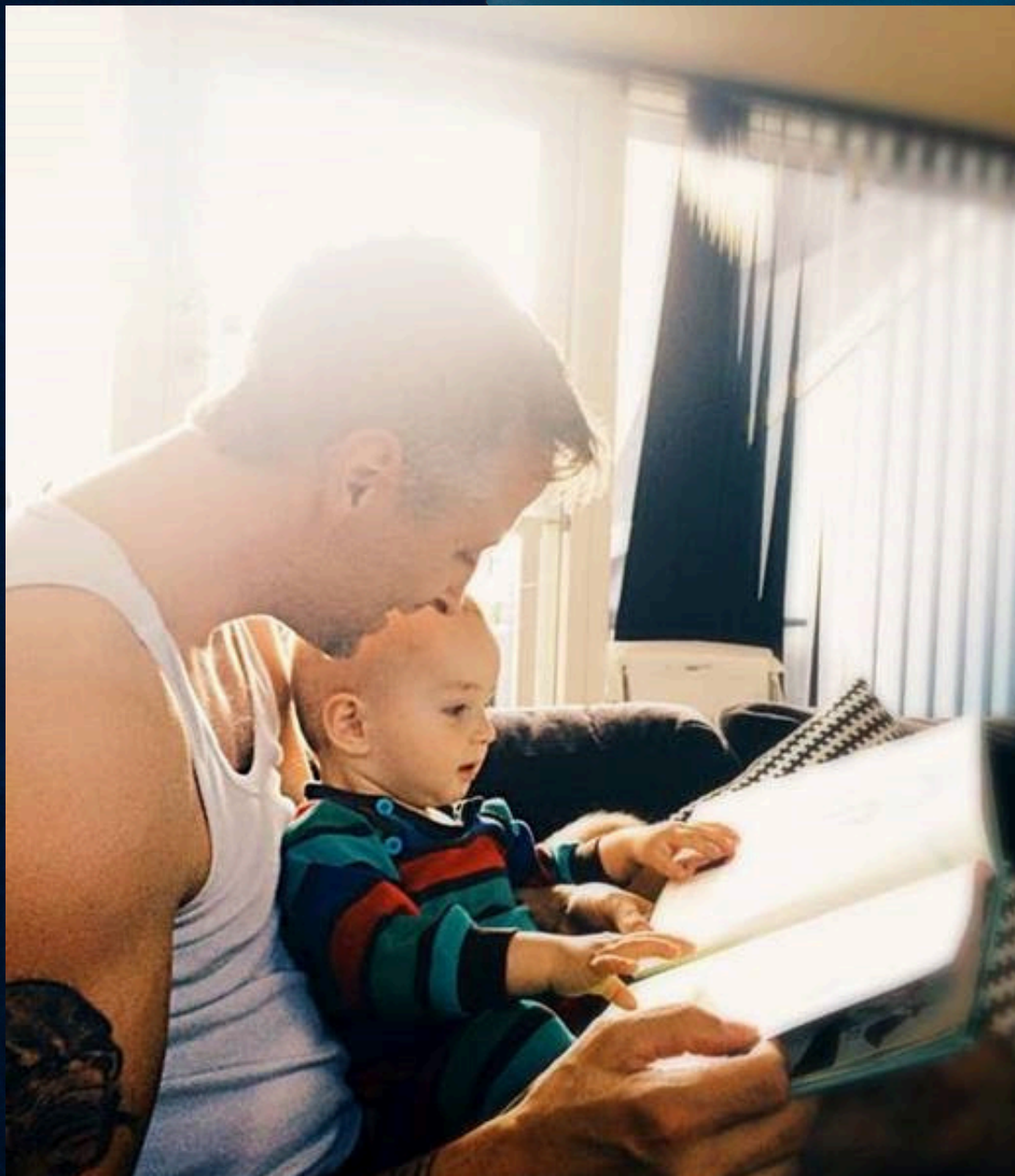
In 2024, we provided regular energy assistance to:

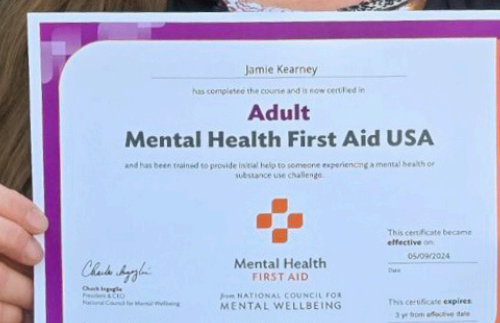
